



Time: 7 hours (round-trip)

Maximum height: 4,650 meters

Difficulty: Moderate.

Season: April – November

Lake 69 is known to many as the jewel of the Callejón de Huaylas. It's impossibly-turquoise color, stunning surrounding glaciers, and rich vegetation make it an unforgettable hike.

We will head north of Huaraz at 6am in private transportation through the valley of Huaylas, where we will have the opportunity to go through beautiful villages such as: Yungar, Mancos, Carhuaz, Yungay (Yungay Camposanto). From the city of Yungay we head to the foothills of the Cordillera Blanca, beginning our climb to the Quebrada Llanganuco, where we see the famous Llanganuco Lake. We will arrive at Cebollapampa (3,850 m) and begin our hike of 3 hours to reach the lake 69. We will relax at the lake for 1 hour, taking and then return to Cebollapampa where our vehicle will be waiting for us to return to Huaraz.
