



Time: 6 hours

Maximum height: 4,560 meters

Difficulty: Moderate.

Season: April – November

Lake Aguak is a steep hike located close to Huaraz, making it an excellent acclimatization hike. Condors have been spotted by trekkers arriving at the shores of Aguak, so keep a lookout for these incredible birds!

We leave in private transportation to the village and archaeological ruins of Willcahuain. From there we began our hike on a marked path towards Cerro San Cristobal to Lake Aguak. This lake has a beautiful view of the city of Huaraz, with only 4 hours of walking and an excellent view of the Cordillera Blanca mountains, the valley of Huaylas and of course the Cordillera Negra.

During the walk we will be granted views of Vallunaraju, Churup, Huamashraju, Cashan along with the city of Huaraz. The return trip is approximately 3 hours to Wilcawain, where we will take our vehicle back to Huaraz.
