



Maximum height: 3,900 meters

Difficulty: Easy

Season: April – November

Lake Wilcacocha is an easy trek close to Huaraz, perfect for a half-day or full-day trip to acclimatize. Trekkers will be able to see small villages, rich vegetation, and unbeatable views of the glaciated Cordillera Blanca.

8.00 am: We head south from Huaraz in private transportation to the Santa Cruz bridge. From here we will start ascending a dirt path. We'll see traditional small villages in the Peruvian mountains, along with fields, agricultural work and livestock. After walking for nearly 2 hours we will reach Willcacocha. The lake is an exceptional viewpoint where you will have a spectacular panoramic view of the Cordillera Blanca and the mountains Huascaran, Chopicalqui, Hualcán, Copa, Vallunaraju, Ranrapalca, and Churup.

At approximately 1:30 we will begin our return, passing through the town of Chilca until the Paria bridge, where we take our vehicle back to Huaraz.
