



RADIÁN AND MULLACA HIKE

Maximum height: 4,610 meters

This trek is a hidden gem in the area. The hike passes the romantic heart-shaped Radian lake, travels through a lush quenual forest, and finally arrives to the jaw-dropping turquoise Mullaca lake below the glaciated Nevado Vallunaraju. You may even be lucky enough to spot condors that live in the surrounding area!

We head northeast from Huaraz by private transport to the village Recrish, about 25 minutes away from Willcahuain. Then we started the 4 hour walk. The route climbs gradually. We first arrive at the Laguna Radian, which is not as deep and is surrounded by a beautiful landscape. After a short break to take some pictures, we will continue on a steep path through Quenual forest next to a creek with waterfalls. We will then arrive at Lake Mullaca, better known as Carhuac by local people. We will have a spectacular view of the landscape, including the snowy and icy Vallunaraju and the extensive valley of Huaylas. The return trip will take about 3 hours to reach Recrish, where we will take our vehicle back to Huaraz.
