



The Cordillera Central is located between the departments of Lima and Junin. To approach the west side, you travel from San Mateo, 3 Hours From Lima. Most of the Cordillera Central is protected by Reserva Paisajistica Nor Yauyos Cochas, based in Huancayo.

The best mountains in the east side of the range are Tunsho 5730 m, Pariacaca 5750 m, Antachaire 5700 m., etc.

In the west side of the range, the best and most visited mountains are Nevado Paccha 5400 m., Vicuñaíta 5528 m., Paca 5575 m., etc.

Most of these faces are yet to be summited. The Cordillera Central is an excellent area for trekkers and climbers who are looking for unexplored, new places. In this range, visitors can still see wild Pumas, Andean cats and Condors. Write to us for recommendations on easy and challenging climbs and treks, depending on your interest.
