



Three day trek on a Pre-Inca trail, passing through ancestral villages in the Callejón de Huaylas and Valle de Conchucos. The route ends above the Archeologic Ruins of Chavín. An excellent option for outdoor and culture/history buffs.

DAY 1: HUARAZ - OLLEROS - SACRACANCHA:

8:00 am. We will head south from Huaraz towards Olleros (3,420 msnm). From here we will arrive in Canrey Chico, where the mule drivers will await us to begin our trek. After a three hour hike, we arrive in Sacracancha (4,080 m), where we will set up camp.

Dinner and overnight in Sacracancha.

DAY 2: TSCRACANCHA - YANASHALLAS - SHONGOPAMPA:

After breakfast in camp, we will begin our second day of heading, setting out towards Yanashallas (4,700 m). Our hike will continue, and we will descend switchbacks until we arrive at Shongopampa (4,088 m).



Dinner and overnight in Shongopampa.

DAY 3: SHONGOPAMPA - CHAVÍN - HUARAZ:

After breakfast in the camp, we will head out towards Chavin, descending through the Shongo gorge. We will pass through the Huchacsa gorge to arrive at the Archeological Monument of Chavin (3,150 msnm); we will have 2 hours to enjoy the ruins and learn about the Chavin culture.

In the afternoon we will make the two hour journey in private transportation back to Huaraz, passing through the Cahuish tunnel (4,550 masl and 480 m long), as well as passing by Querococha lake (3,980 m).
